ACTIVITIES

State team selection trials

As already stated in the previous report Covid 19 pandemic shattered the State Swimming training & competitions in a big way. All the training centres were closed down for more than a year refraining swimmers from their regular practices. Since Swimming Federation of India has decided to conduct the Sub Junior, Junior & Senior National Championship at Bangalore during the last week of October, we conducted the selection trials to select the State teams for National participation at Dr. B. R. Ambedkar International Aquatic Complex, Pirappancode on September. Simultaneously we arranged a trials at Dubai also for the convenience of Swimmers training there, under the supervision of S. Pradeepkumar, National Coach. State swimming team was finalised by comparing with the timing recorded at Dubai and at Pirappancode.

10th Kerala State Masters Swimming Championship - Pakakkad
